To forge closer collaboration between Hong Kong and London maritime industry after a Memorandum of Understanding was signed in September last year, the Hong Kong Maritime and Port Board (HKMPB) and Maritime London will organise a “Hong Kong-London Maritime Day” in the morning of 22 November. Forum on Guangxi-Hong Kong Port and Logistics Cooperation (22 Nov)

Following the development of the “International Land-Sea New Trade Channel”, the Transport and Housing Bureau of the HKSAR Government will jointly organise a “Forum on Guangxi-Hong Kong Port and Logistics Cooperation” with the Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region Beibu Gulf Economic Zone Planning and Management Office in the afternoon of 22 November, with the support of the co-organiser Hong Kong Trade Development Council. The Forum aims at facilitating exchanges of views and deepening of collaboration among port, logistics and maritime industry personalities in Guangxi and Hong Kong. Officials of the HKSAR Government and Guangxi Government will deliver speeches at the event, whereas industry figures of both places will take part in the panel discussion.
