With just a few more days to go, Hong Kong Maritime Week (HKMW) 2021 is set to hit the ground. From 31 October to 6 November, a total of 38 activities will be hosted by more than 40 industry players and organisations.

HKMW 2021 will feature nine themes. Green Shipping and Decarbonisation is perhaps the most highly anticipated. Nearly 20% of the forums and seminars of HKMW2021 are entirely or partially devoted to this complex topic to investigate and overcome the challenges together.

With the arrival of the pandemic and its shocking ability to inhibit physical intervention, shipping is being transformed to digitalisation at lightning speed. Under the new normal, ships are being inspected via a drone, while vital vessel performance data is made available to interested parties via a mobile app.

Going forward, digitalisation will enhance ship operations in ways that can be barely imagined today. Event organisers of the Week such as Seatrade Maritime, the Institute of Chartered Shipbrokers, the CY Tung International Centre for Maritime Studies, and others have recruited experts to give you the best picture of shipping's automated future.
