### ALMC, 23-24 NOV

Being the largest event of its kind in Asia, Asian Logistics and Maritime Conference (ALMC), co-organised by the Government of HKSAR and HKTDC has been a major logistics and maritime event in Hong Kong over the years. It has become HKMW's anchor event since 2016. ALMC 2017 will feature around 70 luminaries from the logistics and maritime industries as the speakers, and attract around 100 exhibitors and 2 000 participants from home and abroad.
